Abbreviated Summary of Jordi Roma's Curriculum Vitae:

Specialist in Internal Medicine from UAB in 1979. Graduated in Health Sciences Statistics from the same university. In 1992, I joined the Pharmaceutical Industry in the medical department of Prodesfarma S.A., serving as the Medical Director until 1998. I took on the development of Aceclofenac, first obtaining its approval from the Spanish Ministry of Health, then from the UK drug agencies, and finally becoming the first Spanish active ingredient to receive approval from the European Medicines Agency. Equally significant was the establishment of the first Pharmacovigilance department and involvement in the emerging ICH E3 (Single Case Report). Until late 2003, I led a pharmaceutical research unit at the Centre Hospitalari de Manresa, actively participating in over 100 clinical trials, from Phase I to Phase III, including bioequivalence studies of various products, with a preferred partnership with Simbec International UK. During these years, I was an active member of the Clinical Trials Ethics Committee.

In recent years, my professional activity has been focused on the production and research of pharmaceutical products, primarily in the field of new generics and second opportunities for well-known medications.
